I am pleased to present the new and improved annual report for Apologetics for the Church. In previous years I used a Microsoft Word formatted document to summarize all that God has done through the ministry, but this new annual report reflects the massive changes taking place in the ministry. 2024 was a seminal year for Apologetics for the Church, in many ways. Thanks to generous donors and a flood of volunteers, we purchased more than \$10,000 of recording equipment and launched a YouTube channel, a second (and much improved) season of our podcast, secured a long-term commitment on our radio program and began a serious effort to spread the work of the ministry across multiple social media platforms.

These efforts have brought national and international exposure to the ministry. I hear regularly from people across the globe about how they have benefitted from our focus on equipping ordinary believers to effectively and confidently engage unbelievers with the good news of the gospel. I hope your excitement grows as you peruse this report, and I ask that you continue to pray for the continued growth of Apologetics for the Church.

Sam served as a pastor for eleven years before transitioning to seminary and college teaching, where he has served as a seminary president and professor. He is a widely respected leader and counselor.


Rodney Pearce, MDiv.


Dan Esquirell, CPA, MBA, CFP

In 2024, our total income was \$49,571, primarily from generous donations, resource sales, conferences, and services. Expenses totaled \$52,421, covering research, podcast production, books, conferences, travel, and operations. A significant investment in recording and editing equipment has enhanced our podcast's quality, enabling us to reach a broad online audience with impactful apologetics teaching. While costs exceeded income, every dollar was invested strategically to advance our mission.

Notably, Dr. Mark Farnham does not take a salary at this time, allowing funds to directly support ministry efforts. We remain committed to wise stewardship as we expand our reach.

OUR GOALS

FOR 2025

Podcast, Print, and Video Production

In 2024 we produced 16 videos for our new YouTube channel and a new season of podcast episodes. In 2025 we hope to produce 75 videos and podcast episodes as well as a number of short, printed pieces for free distribution on popular topics, such as the problem of evil and suffering, the reliability of Scripture, and the deity of Christ. In addition to our YouTube channel, we are now posting short videos on several social media sites, which has an extensive reach around the world.

Refined Internship Program

We began welcoming interns in summer 2023 and refined the program to some degree in 2024 with our first year-long intern, Brandon, and our second student intern, Kayla (see the Team page). In 2025 we hope to take on more interns with the intent that we multiply the impact of Apologetics for the Church. This will help us move closer to the goal of employing Associate Apologists who can travel to conference opportunities that we presently cannot fill. In recent years Mark has received invitations from Egypt, Togo, Uganda, and other countries that he hasn't been able to fulfill.

Redesigned Website

As you can see, God has brought together an amazing team of volunteers to help the ministry grow in new directions. One of the benefits of this team is that we have completely redesigned our website to make it a place with many more resources to equip ordinary believers. The website now provides links to such resources as our blog, podcast, YouTube channel, free study guide, Everyone Worships website, and other free resources.

Publication of the Apologetics Curriculum

In 2020, Dr. Farnham completed a sevenyear project of writing a 35-week Christian School and church curriculum. Initially, a publishing company contracted to develop the curriculum, but rescinded the contract in 2023, due to creative differences. In 2025 we will seek either a new traditional publisher or an online platform to make the material available to schools and churches.

Increase Support

Our fundraising efforts at the end of 2024 resulted in \$7,000 of one-time gifts and the addition of three new monthly supporters. Because new opportunities are arising all the time, we hope to raise \$20,000 in onetime gifts and ten new monthly supporters in 2025. This will enable us to continue to produce new resources, accept more interns, and invest in new projects, such as hosting regional conferences for churches.

WHAT HAPPENED IN 2024



Book Publishing

A major publishing effort was completed in 2024. A two-year project concluded on the basic philosophy book, *Talking About Worldviews: A Conversational Introduction to Philosophy* (Kregel, forthcoming). Written from a distinctly Christian perspective, it teaches philosophy through a fictional discussion between four young adults—a Christian, an atheist, an existentialist, and a Buddhist. The book will be released in late 2025 or early 2026.

Formation of an Amazing Team

Throughout 2023-24 God has miraculously brought together a number of truly talented people to volunteer their expertise for the improvement and advancement of the ministry. This may be the single greatest success of the year, and it was all God's doing. He is the one who laid it on the hearts of all the people who now comprise "The Team."

Consultations

In addition to the conferences and seminars held in 2024, Dr. Farnham has consulted on dozens of podcast interviews, apologetics-related meetings, zoom calls, phone calls, and emails. Requests for help come almost weekly from people, pastors, and churches around the country.


Special Seminar Hosted

In September, Apologetics for the Church co-sponsored an event, Dignity Beyond Accomplishment: Valuing All People in a Culture of Death with Dr. Justin Hawkins (PhD, Yale). As the brother of someone born with Down Syndrome, Justin is a leading advocate for the sanctity of all human life. Justin lectured to an audience of more than 30 ministry leaders and proposed ways believers can continue to exalt the sanctity of life.

REPUBLICATION

P&R Publishing contacted Dr. Farnham in early 2024 to consider republishing his first book, *Every Believer Confident: Apologetics for the Ordinary Christian*. They offered a contract in August and the project was fast-tracked in 45 days. This was an intense accomplishment that required almost daily communications between Mark and P&R. The project was completed in October and the new cover and layout were complete by November. The new edition was released in January 2025, with an extensive marketing campaign.

The new edition of the book includes a number of changes. The last three chapters on theological topics have been removed and replaced with a single chapter on "Gospel Conversations in Ongoing Relationships." The publisher felt this replacement fit the general tenor of the book better. Additionally new study questions and case studies were added to every chapter. This makes the book more useful in small groups and Sunday School classes. Early sales of the book have been outstanding!
